The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry is recruiting for four job categories:

- [Tax Law Compliance Specialist \(1 opening\) – August 12, 2017 application deadline.](#)
This position is responsible for developing, maintaining, monitoring, and enforcing standard operating procedures to ensure compliance with statutes, administrative codes and handbook requirements affecting the implementation and administration of [Wisconsin's Forest Tax Laws](#).
- [Tax Law Forestry Specialists \(9 openings statewide\) – August 12, 2017 application deadline.](#)
The Tax Law Forestry Specialists provide field administration, coordination & enforcement of the forest tax laws in collaboration with the Tax Law Team Leaders and other Tax Law positions.
- [Forester – Senior \(various locations statewide\) – August 13, 2017 application deadline.](#)
Foresters provide a wide range of services that include; developing, administering, and evaluating forest management programs for county, state, and private forestlands; establishing and administering timber sales on department-managed forestlands; performing fire preparedness, suppression, prevention, and training. Candidates are required to have a four-year SAF accredited degree in forestry (or equivalent as determined by the Chief State Forester).
- [Forestry Technician \(various locations statewide\) – August 13, 2017 application deadline.](#)
Forestry technicians provide a wide range of services that include: prepare timber sales, prepare and recommend reforestation plans; control insect and disease attacks; perform fire preparedness, suppression, prevention, and training; and operate and maintain fire control heavy equipment.
