JOB CLASSIFICATION: Natural Resource Engineer 2 - (This position may be filled at the Natural Resource Engineer 1, In-Training level)

SALARY RANGE: N.R.Engineer 1: \$3,377 - \$4,429 per month; (\$3,276- \$4,296 with 3% temporary reduction)
N.R. Engineer 2: \$3,819 - \$5,010 per month;(\$3,704 - \$4,860 with 3% temporary reduction)

TYPE OF POSITION: Permanent with benefits, Full-time. Open until filled.

POSITION PROFILE:

At the NRE1 In-Training level, under close supervision, this position performs assigned forest engineering work in office or field, designing forest transportation and harvesting systems, and administration of construction/maintenance contracts for the Straits District of the Olympic Region. Upon successful completion of In Training plan this position will automatically promote to NRE2.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Proficiency in the use of engineering equipment, tools and common software, such as Word, Excel, AutoCAD, ArcGIS, and RoadEng.
- Proficiency in basic survey procedures and use of equipment to collect and process field data for design, construction and costing of engineering projects.
- Ability to prepare detailed and accurate descriptions, contracts, cost sheets, etc. for engineering projects
- Knowledge of forest engineering principles, techniques and applications such as: logging systems, harvest system design and road transportation design.
- Ability to follow guidelines and request additional information and assistance when needed
- Strong written and verbal communication skills

This level of knowledge, skill and competency is typically acquired by having:

- A Bachelor's degree in Forest Engineering or Civil Engineering, **OR**
- A Bachelor's degree in Forestry or related Natural Resources field, and subsequent to graduation, one year of engineering experience in harvest system design, forest transportation system design OR forest road construction/maintenance and/or contract administration.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge and understanding of field data collection, drafting, design and installation of fish passage structures
- Knowledge of forest practice standards, laws and rights-of-way.
- Knowledge of contract administration and compliance.
